## Question:

How to use foreign keys when a COBOL program accesses DBMaker with DCI?  
(DBMR2780)

## Answer:

In order to use foreign keys when a COBOL program accesses DBMaker with DCI, users should ensure that the xml file matches the table.

Users need to change "open i-o" to "open output" in the COBOL program to create table "CET\_ANALISE\_PROPOSTA", and then add foreign keys by hand, and finally change "open output" to "open i-o" before running the COBOL program.
