

# DBMaker/DBMaster FAQ Document

## Question:

How can I access DBMaker if I didn't register the DSN?

## Answer:

If you didn't register the DSN ,you should use indiscriminately the following connection string when you use ADO

```
strConn="Driver=DBMaker4.1Driver;DATABASE=Dbample4;SvAdr=192.168.0.164;PtNum=8888;UID=sysadm;Pwd=;ATCMT=1;"
```

You need to pay attention to following proceedings

1. Don't change the order of the keywords in the connection string.
2. To the different Databases, you need to modify the values of the following three parameters: DATABASE=Dbample4; SvAdr=192.168.0.164; PtNum=8888
- 3.To the different versions of DBMaker and DBMaker you need to pay attention to the setting of the parameter Driver=DBMaker 4.1 Driver ;following are the examples:

eg Access the DBMaker 4.1, set Driver=DBMaker 4.1 Driver;

Access the DBMaker 4.2, set Driver=DBMaker 4.2 Driver;

Access the DBMaker 4.1, set Driver=DBMaker 4.1 Driver;

Access the DBMaker 4.2, set Driver=DBMaker 4.2 Driver;
