

# DBMaker/DBMaster FAQ Document

## Question:

If the customer set specific time for PITR like 02/10 10:00:00, dbmaker can recover the database to the exact time? (DBMR1968; Version: DBMaker 4.3.4 bundle)

## Answer:

Yes, DBMaker can restore the database to the exact time (DB\_RTime).

When doing recover with setting DB\_RTime, dbmaker will compare time of journal records in each journal file, if time of journal record is before DB\_RTime, journal record will be restored. For uncommitted transaction, it will do rollback.
